Dear Friends,

This week, I joined local leaders and our Public Health Director to announce a partnership that will keep our communities better informed about COVID-19 cases. [Citizen launched their SafePass app](#), which enables residents to track their symptoms, get notified when they've come in contact with someone who contracted COVID-19, and ensure better physical distancing in our community. If an individual tests positive, the app will provide an anonymous alert to their contacts and provide options for nearby testing sites. All of the data collected through the contact tracing system is encrypted, stored securely for 30 days, and then permanently deleted. These privacy precautions are intended to fully protect users and their contacts.

This initiative will complement Los Angeles County's existing contract tracing efforts. Efficient and thorough contact tracing is critical to interrupt ongoing transmission and reduce community spread. We hope this will give us more peace of mind knowing our friends and neighbors are safe and healthy. As we do our part to protect Los Angeles County's communities, we can move forward on our path to reopening and recovery.
