### Financial Relief & Grants for Small Business:



#### *Keep LA County Dining*

In an effort to assist Los Angeles County restaurants affected by COVID-19 restrictions, Los Angeles County is launching the Keep LA County Dining Program, to provide grants of up to \$30,000 to qualifying restaurants. Applications will be accepted from December 3, 2020 at 12:00 AM until December 6, 2020 11:59 PM, or until 2,500 applications have been received. #### ***California Announces Tax Relief and \$500 million in Small Business Grants***



Yesterday, the Governor announced billions in immediate, temporary tax relief to support businesses impacted by COVID-19, including an automatic three-month extension for taxpayers filing less than \$1 million in sales tax and interest-free payment agreements to larger companies with up to \$5 million in sales tax. Additionally, California will provide \$500 million in new COVID-19 Relief Grant funding for small businesses.

Small business grants would distribute relief up to to \$25,000 to underserved micro and small businesses through the state by early 2021, and non-profit organizations would also be eligible for these grants. The California Office of the Small Business Advocate (CalOSBA) is establishing the program, and will make it available to small business as soon as possible. ## Update: LA County Temporary Safer- At- Home Order

From November 30, 2020 to at least December 20, 2020, Los Angeles County has enacted a Temporary Targeted Safer At Home Order, which urges residents to:

- remain in residences as much as practicable
- limit close contact with others outside household (both indoor and outdoor spaces)

The Order reduces capacity at sites where non-household members interact, especially in places where persons are in close proximity. Residents of LA County are urged to stay home, except to travel to and from essential businesses, to work at or provide service to a healthcare operation or essential infrastructure, in essential activities, perform or obtain services from essential governmental function, or participate in permitted individual or household activities while practicing social distancing.

The order continues the suspension of in-person dining, closes public playgrounds and halts public and private events and gatherings. Read more about the Order [here](#).

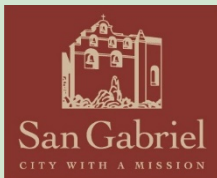
