We are pleased to report that at the regularly scheduled June 1, 2021 Meeting of the San Gabriel City Council, the Council **voted in favor of Resolution No. 21-19, adopting a Vote of No Confidence in Los Angeles County District Attorney George Gascon**, due to the policies and directives he has issued.

There was tremendous community engagement surrounding this matter. **Approximately 115 Public Comments were submitted.** It was Mayor Chin Ho Liao's recommendation that EVERY Public Comment be read aloud into the Record as a show of respect and appreciation. The Council voted unanimously in agreement. It was extremely interesting to hear the various opinions and perspectives of those who wrote in!

After all Public Comments had been read, the Council engaged in deep discussions and deliberations.

In addition to proposed Resolution No. 21-19, Council was also tasked with considering an alternate version of the Resolution proposed by Council Member Jason Pu.

At the end of the lengthy discussion and deliberation, the San Gabriel City Council voted 4-1 in favor of Resolution No. 21-19, adopting a Vote of No Confidence in Los Angeles County District Attorney George Gason.

San Gabriel joined with several other cities who have also considered similar Resolutions, including Rosemead, Arcadia, Azusa, Diamond Bar, Covina, Whittier, Santa Fe Springs, Manhattan Beach, Lancaster, Pico Rivera and Beverly Hills.
