## A Letter from Los Angeles County Supervisor Hilda L. Solis

Dear Friends,

March is National Women's History Month and I would like to take this time to reflect and honor the millions of women who make up LA County, this great nation, and the entire world. Throughout my career, I have had the privilege to meet wonderful women in different capacities. From single moms working tirelessly everyday to provide for their children, to daughters who are giving their best in higher education aspiring to become professionals, to grandmas who have served as the backbone of their families, to the Ukrainian women fighting for their country and our democracy, I am so proud you.

Like so many women, I spent my career being in rooms and sitting at tables filled with men. And when there were women at the table, I was usually the only woman of color. I was the first woman to win the John F. Kennedy Profile in Courage Award, the first Latina to serve in the California State Senate, and the first Latina to serve in the Presidential Cabinet. I was incredibly proud to assume each of those roles, but we need to make more progress so that this is the norm instead of the exception. It's not new, but I'm glad that it's changing.

To all the women reading this, I urge you to help create a world where every young girl and woman activates her infinite potential for change. We are strong, we are smart, and we are capable.

## Supporting Caregivers at SEIU 2015

## LA County Launches a Guaranteed Income Program



LA County is launching a guaranteed income program to provide residents the chance to "breathe" easier knowing they are more financially secure. This program will provide 1,000 randomly selected eligible residents with \$1,000 per month for three years.

Residents must meet all requirements:

- Be 18 years of age or older
- Live in a Los Angeles County neighborhood that falls at or below 100% of the County's Area Median Household Income (AMI)

- Have been negatively financially impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic
- Have a household income that falls at or below 100% of the County's AMI, for a single person household

OR

- Have a household income that falls at or below 120% of the County's AMI for households with two or more persons

## \$7 Million in Federal Funding for First District Projects



I can't thank enough our Congressional leaders for passing the Federal Fiscal Year 2022 omnibus spending bill which includes funding for several projects that I have spearheaded since taking office as First District Supervisor.

The spending bill, which would provide funding for federal agencies for the balance of the federal fiscal year (ending September 30, 2022), includes allocations of \$7 million in earmarks toward the following projects in the First District:

- \$1.5 million for MacLaren Community Park Project
- \$1.5 million for the San Gabriel Valley Aquatic Center
- \$1.5 million for the Rosemead Boulevard Complete Streets project
- \$1.5 million for pre-development activities to support affordable housing at Lot 45 in Chinatown
- \$1 million for East Los Angeles/Florence-Firestone Bus Stop Improvements

Access to open spaces and complete streets are a matter of public health and social equity. Since taking office, I have worked tirelessly to jump-start these projects in partnership with community – including authoring several funding motions with resources available by the County.

However, this action by our Congressional leaders will help us close the gaps and finally be able to enhance the health of our under-resourced communities.


