A Letter from Los Angeles County Supervisor Hilda L. Solis

Dear Friends,

Next week, we will commemorate the legacy of a leader in the civil rights and labor movement: Cesar E. Chavez. He was a national civil rights leader and an extraordinary man who saw injustice and decided to do something about it. Cesar experienced first-hand what it was like to work in unsafe conditions and to earn unfair wages. The injustices he faced motivated him to fight for basic rights for him and his fellow farm workers. Cesar Chavez understood that, as Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. said, whatever affects one directly, affects all indirectly... that our fates are inextricably linked to one another... and that the people united will never be divided.

Under his leadership, the United Farm Workers organized sit-ins, strikes, boycotts and Cesar even endured numerous hunger strikes in order to draw attention to the interrelated issues of fairness and safety in the workplace. They knew that change never comes easily and it always requires ordinary people doing extraordinary things. Together, they paved the way for a federal minimum wage, safe working conditions, and reasonable work hours. It is because of their collective efforts that they fundamentally improved the way workers were treated in this country.

March 31 will mark what would have been Cesar's 95th birthday. Although no longer with us, we honor his legacy by reflecting on his life's work and how it has informed and elevated today's civil rights agenda, not only for the Latino community, but for all communities of color. Let's all take some time to remember his legacy and remember that we are all in the struggle together and we can only overcome it together.

Get \$1,000 per Month for Three Years!

BREATHE
LA COUNTY'S
GUARANTEED INCOME PROGRAM

Application process begins March 31st

LA County's Guaranteed Income Program will award 1,000 randomly selected qualifying residents \$1,000 a month for three years—giving them financial space to breathe.

To be eligible for this project, applicants must meet **all** of these requirements:

- Be 18 years of age or older

- Live in a Los Angeles County neighborhood that falls at or below 100% of the County's Area Median Household Income (AMI) (see [Eligibility Map](#))
- Have a household income that falls at or below 100% of the County's AMI, for a single person household, or have a household income that falls at or below 120% of the County's AMI for households with two or more persons (see [Income Eligibility Table](#))
- Have been negatively financially impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic
- Not be currently enrolled in another Guaranteed Income project offered by the County, a city, or other public or private entity

Only one person per household is eligible. The enrollment period starts on Thursday, March 31 and ends on April 13, 2021. Selection will not depend on the timing of entries.

Safety Measures for Workers and Customers



As a reminder, employers are required to offer free medical grade masks and respirators (N95, KN95, KF94) to employees working indoors in close contact with other workers, customers, and/or members of the public at all sites where masking indoors is optional. At worksites where masking remains required, employers need to provide employees with free, well-fitting medical masks.

Employers are also obligated to offer testing free of charge during work hours to any employee exposed to COVID-19 at work. In order to reduce transmission at worksites, employers are required to report any cluster of worksite COVID-19 cases to the Department of Public Health. A cluster is three or more laboratory-confirmed cases of COVID-19 at the worksite within a 14-day period. Reports to Public Health should be made as soon as possible and no later than 48 hours after reports or knowledge of at least three cases.

To file a complaint with Public Health, which can be submitted anonymously, workers can call the Environmental Health Customer Call Center at (888) 700-9995 or click on the "Report a Problem" at www.ph.lacounty.gov/eh. To file a complaint with Cal/OSHA about employee safety,

workplace safety, or hazardous conditions, workers can call (833) 579-0927 or call or email the local Cal/OSHA Enforcement Office that serves the location of the job site.

RENT RELIEF

The California COVID-19 Rent Relief program provides free financial assistance for both landlords and renters who have been impacted by COVID-19 and need help with unpaid or future rent or utilities, regardless of their immigration status. The financial assistance does NOT count as earned income (for renters) and will NOT affect eligibility for any other state benefit assistance programs, such as CalFresh or CalWORKS.

The deadline to apply is Thursday, March 31.
