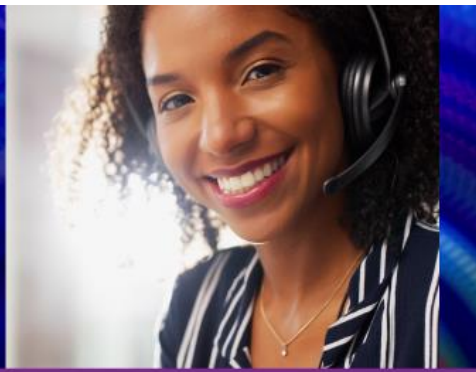

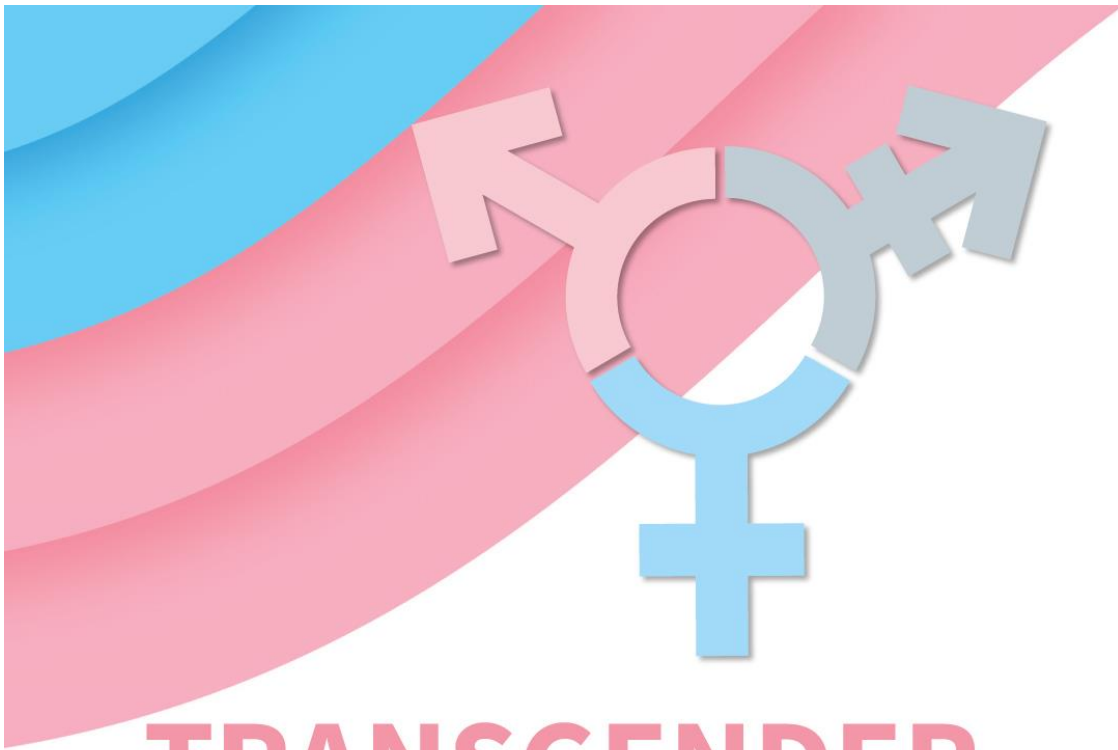
Adopt a Family for the Holiday Season!

RECOVERY GRANTS AVAILABLE FOR CHILDCARE PROVIDERS

If your childcare business has been affected by COVID-19, the L.A. County Development Authority is here to help with grant amounts for eligible licensed family childcare homes begin at \$15,000 and \$40,000 for eligible licensed childcare centers. The applications process is open from November 15, 2022 until February 14, 2023.
