City of San Gabriel Small Business Assistance Grants



Starting April 6, 2023 at 10:00am, eligible businesses can apply to the City's Small Business Assistance grant program. Applications will be available and must be submitted **ONLINE ONLY** at the City's website, www.sangabrieled.com. This program provides one-time financial assistance to businesses seeking general assistance or relocation assistance. Grants for general assistance are in the amount of \$2,500; grants for relocation assistance are in the amount of \$7,500 or \$10,000.

Economic Opportunity Grant Program - Phase 2 Open

The LA County Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) will disburse over \$54 million across 6,800 grants for small and microbusinesses and nonprofit agencies through the new Economic Opportunity Grants Program (EOG), prioritizing the most COVID-impacted regions and organizations in LA County.
