City of San Gabriel Small Business Assistance Grants



The City of San Gabriel launched its Business Assistance Grants earlier this month! Currently, the City is accepting applications for the Relocation Assistance Grant. Eligibility requirements for the Relocation Assistance Grant include:

- Established business must be relocating within the City of San Gabriel;
- Business must have moved and be open for business by December 31, 2023;

Relocation Assistance applicants must also submit the following with their application:

- Current lease or purchase agreement, dated January 1, 2022, or later, indicating location of business in the City of San Gabriel; and
- Previous lease or purchase agreement, dated before current lease or purchase agreement, indicating business was in another location in the City of San Gabriel.

The deadline for Relocation Assistance is January 1, 2024, or when the City receives enough qualified applications. There is currently a waitlist for General Assistance as the City has already received enough eligible applications; received applications are currently being reviewed.

The Program requires these grants to be awarded on a first-come-first-served basis in specified amounts depending on the applicant's annual gross revenue in the 2019 taxable year.

- 243 RESIDENTIAL UNITS
- 80,000 SF OF RETAIL SPACE

Site construction of shoring and excavation started. This phase of construction is anticipated to be done by Summer 2023.



CURIO HOTEL PROJECT 101 W. VALLEY BLVD.

- 225 HOTELS ROOM, 87 RESIDENTIAL UNITS
- 32,823 SF OF RETAIL SPACE

Project exteriors are complete; interior work is currently being done. The SCE undergrounding work at the corner of Del Mar and Valley is now complete which will allow construction to continue at the eastern (Condominium) portion of the project.
