The Los Angeles Regional Small Business Legal Aid Program provides free legal education and direct representation to qualified small businesses that have been negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic on a number of legal issues. These include issues relating to: drafting and reviewing commercial leases and negotiating with landlords, drafting and reviewing contracts, business



structure and entity formation; employment law advice; application of COVID-19 regulations to business operations; accessing COVID-19 relief including loans and aid; and other transactional legal matters like intellectual property assistance. 
